In keeping with the Department of Human Resources' mission to "work in partnership with others, to effectively deliver compassionate, innovative, and accountable services to individuals, families and communities," the Regional Transportation Offices work in concert with transportation/human service providers and oversee a concerted effort to provide transportation services to consumers participating in qualifying services in the Division of Aging Services (DAS), Division of Family and Children Services (DFCS), the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Addictive Diseases (MHDDAD), the Division of Public Health, as well as the Georgia Department of Labor's Vocational Rehabilitation Services Program (DOL/VRS) and Good WORKS Program.

Region 2 is located in North Georgia and covers the following counties: Banks, Dawson, Forsyth, Franklin, Habersham, Hall, Hart, Lumpkin, Rabun, Stephens, Towns, Union and White. Agencies that are currently being served by DHR Transportation are the Division of Aging Services (DAS), Division of Family and Children Services (DFCS), the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Addictive Diseases (MHDDAD) and DFCS TSS.

Gainesville, GA is located on the shores of Lake Lanier and at the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains. This City of Excellence is the economic center of Northeast Georgia as well as home to more than 30,000 people.

Gainesville has received many titles over the years because of its location and because of its people. The most notable are Queen City of the Mountains and the Poultry Capital. The most recent designation came during 1996 when Gainesville served as host for the 1996 Olympic Rowing/Kayaking Venue. An NBC broadcaster called Gainesville, "Hospitality Capital of the World."

There is much to see and do in Hall County. Popular attractions include but are not limited to Lake Lanier Islands, North Georgia Mountains, Road Atlanta, Lanier National Speedway, Elachee Nature Science Center, Chateau Elan Winery and Resort, Quinlan Visual Arts Center, and Alta Vista Cemetery which is the final resting place of two former Georgia Governors, James Milton Smith (Gov. 1872-1877) and Allen Daniel Chandler (Gov. 1898-1902) and Confederate General James Longstreet who died in 1904.
